

ABOUT US

Nestled in the natural beauty of Door County's landscape, the Landmark Resort is about creating memories that will linger long after returning home. The Landmark Resort is located in Egg Harbor, which is just over an hour away from Green Bay, 2 hours and 40 minutes from Milwaukee, and 4 hours and 10 minutes from Chicago.

There are 16 different suite types to choose from. Suites can have one-bedroom, one-bathroom; two-bedroom, one-bathroom; two-bedroom, two-bathroom; or three bedroom, two-bathroom. Some bedrooms are enclosed or lofted.


There are three pools at the Landmark Resort—two heated outdoor pools and one indoor pool open 24/7.

There are four lodging buildings on property—Charthouse, Flagship, Navigator, and Harbor—and each has their own hot tub and sauna.

Tennis, pickleball, basketball, and shuffleboard equipment are all available for guest checkout at the Front Desk. We have three courts for tennis or pickleball, one basketball court located behind the children's playground, and two shuffleboard courts.

The fitness center in the Pilothouse features state-of-the-art exercise equipment, such as ellipticals, treadmills, and dumbbells.

There are two nature trails on property, the Red Loop and Patti's Path.



The on-site restaurant Carrington serves some of the best views in Door County from the top of the bluff, alongside a full bar, excellent food, and friendly and attentive service. The menu offers a wide range of appetizers, salads, sandwiches, steaks, fish, American classics, and desserts.

The Landmark Resort is proud to be recognized by the Wisconsin Environmental Initiative with our Travel Green Wisconsin certification.

Electric vehicle charging stations are available in the main parking lot—three units are for a standard electric vehicle hook-up, and three more are for a Tesla hook-up. We provide the most EV charging stations in northern Door County.

Other sustainability practices include: high-efficiency air conditioning units,

energy-efficient pool pumps, LED outdoor lighting, high-efficiency and low-flush toilets that only use 1.28 gallons per flush, and housekeeping limited to an as-needed basis. The Landmark Resort supports the Care for Door County initiative.

There are 9 meeting rooms on property. The Egg Harbor Room, located on the lower level of the Carrington, is the largest with 2,394 square feet. Also located in the Carrington, on the upper level, is the State Room, offering 1,463 square feet and panoramic views of the bay. In the Flagship building are the Schooner (448 sq. ft.) and Spinnaker (534 sq. ft.) Rooms, which both include a flat-screen TV, sink, and full-size refrigerator. Both the Cove (678 sq. ft.) and Anchor (532 sq. ft.) Rooms in the Harbor building feature stunning views of the water and deck access. The Navigator building has the Admiral Room (639 sq. ft.) with a view of the water, and the Regatta Room (1,539 sq. ft.), the second-largest meeting room on property. The Port Room (439 sq. ft.) in the Charthouse building is the only meeting room with a woodside view.
